

ORTHOSIS CARE

CARE

- *Your orthosis is made of a low-temperature plastic material. It will melt in hot water or if left near any heat source. (i.e. in the car on a warm day, near a heat vent, in any direct sunlight, etc.)
- *To clean your orthosis, wipe it down with rubbing alcohol or you may clean the outside with cool, soapy water.
- *You will be provided with 3 stockinette liners for use under the orthosis. To clean them, wash in warm, soapy water and air dry. Additional stockinette is available in the therapy department. A small fee may apply.

ADJUSTMENTS

If you have any areas of pressure or irritation from the orthosis, you may be able to slightly tighten or loosen your orthosis by pinching it together or pulling it apart. If this does not solve the issue, please call the therapy department to make an appointment for an adjustment. If you show up to the office without an appointment, it may be difficult to accommodate you. Please call one of the facilities listed below for an appointment.
